CASUALTY:

Lie down.
You are unconscious.
You can not walk/talk.
You can not assist the unit
in any way.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 110, BP: 90/60.
Respirations shallow and rapid.
Casualty is in severe shock.
Unconscious and not responding.
Respiratory distress.
Multiple organ damage.

CONTROLLER:

If not treated within 5
minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
You can talk.
You can not walk.
You can not assist the unit
except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 126; BP: 80/60;
Respirations rapid and shallow.
Casualty alert but apprehensive.
Abdomen tense, distended and
tender.
Moderate to severe bleeding.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment started in 15
minutes, advise casualty he
is unconscious.
If no treatment in 20
minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
You are unconscious.
You can not walk/talk.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 110, BP: 100/60.
Respiration is shallow and rapid.
Comatose and responsive to pain.
Respiratory distress.
No obvious evidence of vascular
compromises of extremities.
Obvious penetrating wound of
brain.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment started within 15
minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
You can talk.
You can not walk.
You can not assist the unit
except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 124; Respirations
shallow and rapid; BP: 90/60.
Severe hemorrhage.
Abdomen extended and tender.
Alert but apprehensive and in pain.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment begun within
15 minutes, advise casualty he is
unconscious.
If no attempt to stop bleeding in
25 minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
You can talk.
You can not walk.
You can not assist the unit
except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 112; BP: 100/70;
Respirations shallow and rapid.
Casualty is alert but apprehensive.
Tense distended, abdomen.
Moderate hemorrhage from extremities.
Full thickness burns on lower extremities
and trunk greater than 20% of total
body area.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment started in 10
minutes, inform casualty he
is unconscious.
If no treatment begun within 20
minutes, consider KIA.
