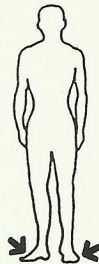

MEDIC:

Respiratory difficulty; respirations
rapid, shallow and labored.
Pulse: 106, BP: 90/60.
Patient alert but apprehensive.

CONTROLLER:

Casualty must proceed with
medical assistance due to high
potential for anaphylactic shock.

Pain and swelling of
right facial area.
Affected area is abcessed
and puss-filled.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
No evidence of external hemorrhage.
Gross deformity of knee.
Neurovascular status remains
uncompromised.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
Casualty is alert, oriented,
complaining of knee pain.
No neurovascular compromise.

L

You can walk/talk.
You can not assist the unit
except by providing information.
Proceed on your own to
the casualty collection point.

MEDIC:

Unilateral low back pain in
lumbosacral/sacroiliac area.
Sacroiliac tenderness.
No obvious neurological signs
or symptoms.
Non-radiating to lower extremities.

MEDIC:

Localized area of thigh
which is erythematous and
tender.
Obvious open lesion near the
center of the area.

Vital signs stable.
Tender areas of face with
proximal red streaking from
the infected areas.
Critical area of infection.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
No signs of sepsis.
Multiple areas of subcutaneous
infection on knee which are

Occasional purulent drainage.

No history or trauma.
Vital signs stable.
Bulge in inguinal area that is
tender and nonreduceable.
Some nausea and vomiting.

You can walk/talk.

Proceed on your own to
the casualty collection point.

MEDIC:

Casualty complaining of pain
in the groin area.
A bulge is in the groin area.
Vital signs are stable.

CASUALTY:

No limitation in function.
Proceed on your own to
the casualty collection point.

MEDIC:

Multiple pubic lice in
pubic hair.
No treatment can be given
at this level.

You can talk.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
Mild to moderate elevation in
temperature.
Abdominal pain.
Nausea.
Occasional vomiting.

MEDIC:

Vital signs are stable,
however, temperature is elevated.
Casualty complaining of abdominal
pain and has generalized tenderness
of the abdomen - more severe in
right lower quadrant.
