 Minimal external hemorrhage
 from head only.
 No respiratory distress.
 Tense and tender suprapubic
 abdomen secondary to penetrating
 injury to bladder.

Lie down.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
 External female genitalia is
 lacerated and avulsed.
 Moderate hemorrhage.

CASUALTY:

You can walk but with great
 difficulty.
 You can talk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.
 Proceed on your own to
 the casualty collection point.

MEDIC:

Vital signs stable.
 Open abrasions on the Libia Majora
 and Minora.
 Minimum loss of tissue.
 Hemorrhage is controlled and
 minimal.

CONTROLLER:

May be led.

GTA 8-11-14

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You can talk.
 You can not walk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.

MEDIC:

No breath sounds, left side.
 Blood foaming at chest wound.
 Pulse rapid and weak.
 Moderate external hemorrhage
 from abdomen wound.
 Evidence of multiple fragment
 wounds.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment started in
 5 minutes, inform casualty he
 is unconscious.
 If no treatment begun within
 10 minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You are unconscious.
 You can not walk/talk.
 You can not assist the unit
 in any way.

MEDIC:

Moderate bleeding from
 both wounds.
 Pupils dilated and non-reactive.
 Pulse: 124, BP: 90/60,
 Respiration shallow and rapid.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You can talk.
 You can not walk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.

MEDIC:

BP: 90/60, Pulse: 110.
 Casualty is alert with no sign
 of neurological deficit.
 Minimal external hemorrhage
 from head only.
 No respiratory distress.
 Tense and tender suprapubic
 abdomen secondary to penetrating
 injury to bladder.

GTA 8-11-14

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You can talk.
 You can not walk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Pulse: 124, Respirations
 rapid and shallow, BP: 80/60.
 Obvious loss of lower extremity
 with severe bleeding.
 Patient alert but apprehensive.
 No other associated injuries.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment begun within 15 minutes,
 advise casualty he is unconscious.
 If no attempt to stop bleeding
 in 25 minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You can talk.
 You can not walk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Blood foaming at chest wound.
 BP: 90/60, tachycardia over 110.
 Respirations shallow and rapid.
 Hemorrhage from both wounds.

CONTROLLER:

If no treatment started in
 5 minutes, inform casualty he
 is unconscious.
 If no treatment begun within
 10 minutes, consider KIA.

CASUALTY:

Lie down.
 You can talk.
 You can not walk.
 You can not assist the unit
 except by providing information.

MEDIC:

Moderate to severe hemorrhage.
 Pulse: 106, BP: 100/60.
 Respiration rapid and shallow.
 Bilateral pelvic fracture.
